



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What days and times are the field trips offered?

Field trips are available in September 2016 from 9:00AM - 11:30AM. Check the availability [calendar](#) to see what dates are available.

What is an acceptable group size for a field trip to Rainbow Orchards?

We are able to accommodate a maximum group of 25 participants including teachers and chaperones. Larger group sizes will be considered at the discretion of the program staff. We aim to keep staff to youth ratios low to maximize the learning experiences.

What do the kids do on field trips?

We follow a general agenda. Our Discovery Day trips are designed to connect all participants with food, health, and the environment.

How much does it cost?

\$275 per maximum class of 25 including teachers and chaperones.

When is payment for the field trip due?

Field trip payments are due no later than 14 days prior to field trip. Once a class is registered El Dorado County Ag in the Classroom will provide an invoice to assist with payment processing. Failure to remit payment may result in registration cancellation.

What forms of payment are acceptable?

We accept checks made out to "El Dorado County Ag in the Classroom" and mailed to EDC AITC, PO Box 522, Shingle Springs, CA 95682 or Visa/MasterCard credit cards by calling us at 530-303-8117.

What if it is raining the day of our field trip?

Field trips may occur in light rain if the visiting group desires. If possible, the field trip may be rescheduled based on availability. In the event that the field trip is canceled due to weather and cannot be rescheduled, a full refund will be issued.

What if I/we need to cancel our scheduled visit?

If the scheduled activity must be canceled for a reason other than weather, and there is not an ability to reschedule on another date, the following applies:

- Cancellations more than 30 days prior to first field trip will receive a full refund.
- Cancellations 8-30 days prior to the event will receive 50% refund.
- Cancellations 7 or less days prior to the event is responsible for 100% of fee payment. No refund will be issued.

Cancellations must be received by El Dorado County Ag in the Classroom in writing.

Can we bring our own snacks for participants to eat during their visit?

Groups or individuals may bring their own food and drink.
