



THANK A FARMER” PROJECT

“Thank A Farmer” gives students the opportunity to “thank a farmer” for their presentation at Farm Day. Students can thank any individual presenter or all presenters. Students should reflect on their favorite learning experience at Farm Day through a brief thank you note and illustration. Artwork will be shared with Ag in the Classroom’s Volunteers.

In creating artwork, children should think about these questions:

- What did you learn at Farm Day?
- What was your favorite Learning Station? Why?
- Did you meet a farmer or someone with an agricultural job? What do they do?
- What senses did you use at Farm Day? Think about sights, smells, touch, sounds, tastes.
- How do you use agriculture in your everyday life? Think about your foods and clothes.

Project Details:

- Artwork may be submitted in any form. For convenience, Ag in the Classroom has a template available online.
- Projects may be done individually, as a class or as a school

- Projects will not be returned and may be used for future promotional opportunities.

- Be grammatically correct
